As you approach Pagoda Gardens from the Heath, you can't help but notice the impressive Pagoda House, a notable example of a beautiful property situated in Blackheath, built in 1760 by Sir William Chambers in the style of a traditional Chinese pagoda. It was later leased to the Prince Regent, who would become King George IV, and used as a summer home by his wife Caroline, Princess of Wales.

The property itself is in need of modernisation and offers great scope to make your own. Comprising of three bedrooms, reception room, kitchen and bathroom/separate WC, each room is of good proportion and could be a great first time buy, buy to let or Pied-A-Terre.



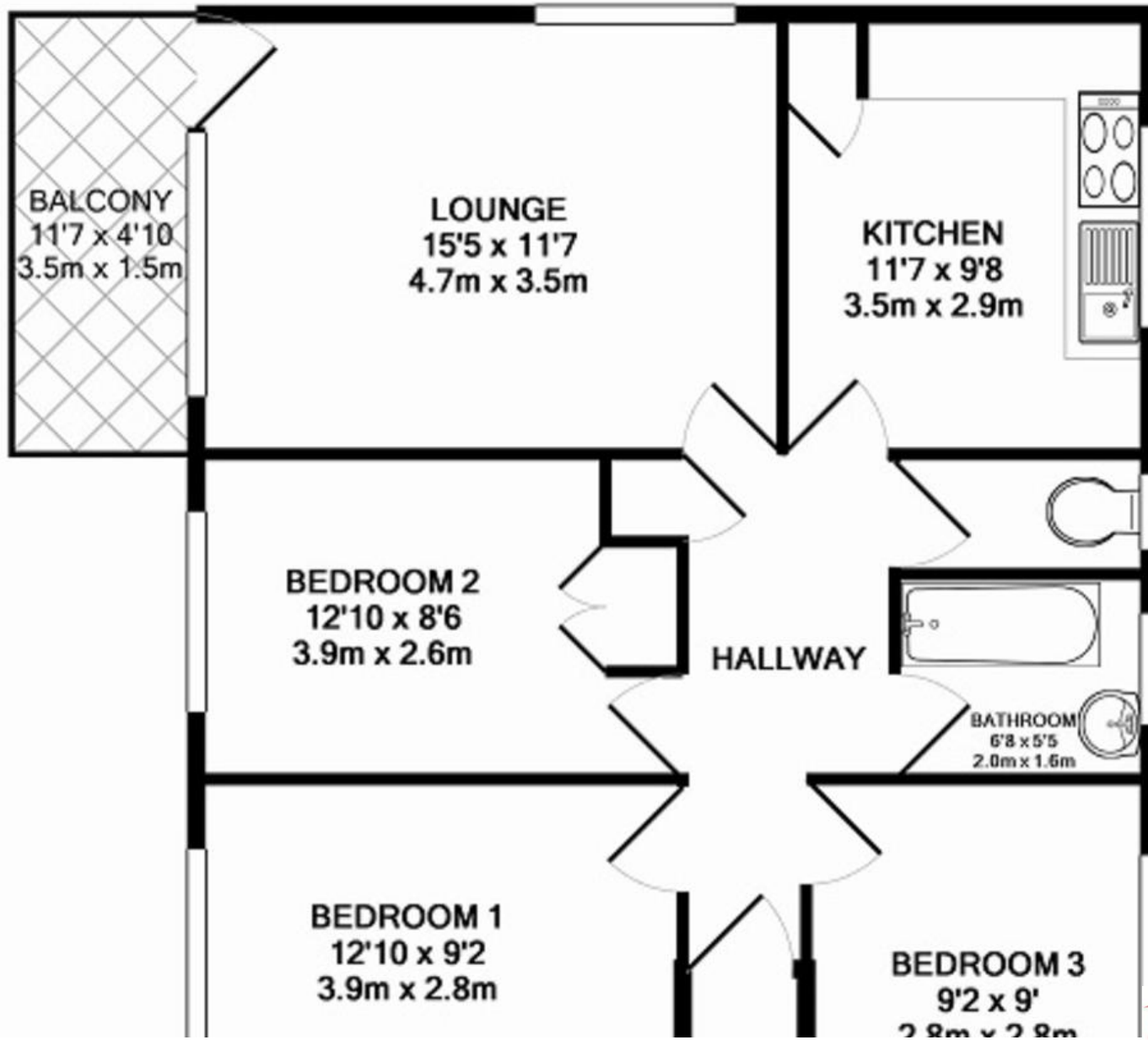
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
